Hot Lunches Update

December Hot Lunch – \$4,008 Revenue, \$1,344 profit January Hot Lunch -- \$3,852 Revenue, \$1,378 profit

Oct to Jan orders -- \$14,897 Revenue, \$4,935 profit (33% margins) Feb and Mar orders-to-date -- \$6,783 Revenue

Budget: \$29,500 Full-year revenue guidance, \$9,000 profit guidance.

Estimate \$9,870 profit by end of the year at current rate.

Garden Project

- Decided at November PAC meeting to fund \$20,000 upgrade to garden space (\$15k taken from PAC general fund, and \$5k to be taken from this year's Walk-a-thon).
- Hatchet & Seed to implement: \$12,500 for fifteen raised garden beds, ~\$2,500 for triple-layer cardboard.
- Hoping to have soil and wood chips donated. Sourcing of plants and seeds to be determined.
- Scraping garden estimated at \$1,000 but cost \$2,500.
 Necessary for project to succeed. Make up elsewhere.
